#1:	What is the theme of Canadian Patient Safety Week? Ask. Listen. Talk.
#2:	Name one important question to ask your health care provider.  Possible Answers:  What is my health problem?  What do I need to do?  Why do I need to do this?  Would you please explain that?  Where can I find more information about?
#3:	Show me your updated medication card. Know and Show ISTA medication card.
#4:	<ul> <li>Why is it important to update your medication card?</li> <li>Possible Answers (or versions thereof):</li> <li>So healthcare providers know my current medications and can assess if my medications are started and stopped correctly</li> <li>To provide important information for emergency responders &amp; ER personnel in an emergency</li> <li>To increase my understanding of my medications and my health condition</li> <li>To reduce medication errors</li> <li>To improve my safety as a patient</li> </ul>
#5:	Why is it important to carry your updated medication card with you at all times?  Possible Answers:  Helps reduce any medication errors if my doctor knows all medications I am taking Allows me to talk about my medications with health care providers Increases my knowledge and participation in my health care Helps to keep me safe
